Pupils

- Make sure rubbish goes in the right bin.
- Make sure fruit waste goes in the compost bucket.
- Do not drop litter!
- Use paper on both sides.
- If you see litter on the floor pick it up.
- Turn the lights off when you leave the room.
- Don't put too much water in your bottle.
- Bring a reusable water bottle.
- Turn the tap off when you finish with it.
- Turn off the board when it is not in use.
- Do not leave Ipads and Chromebooks plugged in all the time
 - only when they need to be charged.
- Respect the school garden and other plants and trees around the school grounds.
- Recycle old pens.
- Do not use plastic bags or cling film in your packed lunch, use wax wraps or reusable plastic/bamboo containers instead
- Put your crisp packets in the recycling bin in the hall.





- Only laminate things if necessary.
- Put tea bags in a tea bag tub for composting.
- Use paper on both sides.
- Turn off boards when they are not in use.
- If you must use glitter only use biodegradable glitter!!
- Do not use plastic craft equipment e.g. googly eyes.
- Only buy peat free compost for gardening.
- Recycle old pens and do not purchase any more felt pens.
- Do not leave Ipads and Chromebooks plugged in all the time - only when they need to be charged.
- When purchasing equipment search for ethical and recyclable options.

Parents

- Try not to use plastic bags or cling film in your child's packed lunch, use wax wraps or reusable plastic/bamboo containers instead.
- Send your child to school with a reusable drink bottle.
- When your child grows out of school uniform pass it on to others.
- Try to walk to school if you live near enough instead of using a car.
